Job Vacancy: Power Distribution Manager (X1). Closes 9Jun2020 (see attached, along with full job description).

NUC invites applications to the position of Power Distribution Manager who will be primarily responsible for the cost-effective conceptual and engineering solutions to upgrade, expand, maintain and automate overhead and underground power distribution systems for Nauru Utilities Corporation.

The Power Distribution Manager ensures compliance with client procedures, design standards, electricity regulatory requirements and safety requirements and will work closely with engineers performing substation, transmission, renewable energy and power storage.

Work will require performing engineering calculations that may include: structural analysis of poles, guying, cable pulling, fault currents, placement of protective devices, development of bills of materials, and estimating costs. Work assignments may include traveling to various project locations to conduct field investigations.

The key responsibilities:

- manage planning, design and monitoring of all power construction, transmission and distribution works.
- monitor performance of power distribution hardware and recommend improvements
- provide engineering and training needs and support to staff
- develop power distribution safe working procedures
- prepare and timely submit power distribution operations reports
- analyse power distribution failures and suggest or implement appropriate resolutions.
- propose to NUC management cost reduction initiatives while maintaining high efficiency of power transmission and distribution systems.
- co-operate fully to any reasonable duties and responsibilities considered appropriate by NUC management.

Key selection criteria:

1. Qualifications

- A Diploma in Electrical & Electronics Engineering, or a related discipline or equivalent experience.

2. Technical expertise

- ten years' practical experience monitoring power distribution and transmission network with at least 4 years directly associated with field operations and managing people

- sound knowledge of planning and design of power distribution systems
- sound knowledge and demonstrated capacity in the operations of power distribution and transmission systems
- sound knowledge of power distribution safe working procedures and PPE
- sound knowledge of power distribution tools and equipment.
- experienced distribution and transmission project development, management and commissioning
- experienced distribution systems faults finding and rectification

3. Language Skills

- Good communication skills in English

4. Interpersonal skills

- A team player, with the ability to lead by example a group of technicians and tradesman to successfully complete necessary task
- Motivating, developing and directing a department with skilled staff
- Ability to solve complex problems
